

INFORMATION TABLE – EU TSE RESEARCH

1. The enclosed table summarises the projects on TSEs that have been funded by the EU Commission since 1993 under the FAIR and FRAMEWORK Programmes.
2. The table has been compiled by the TSE Research Unit in Defra from the available information. If there is additional information that should be included on the table please forward to peter.barrowman@defra.gsi.gov.uk
3. For ease of use the projects have been listed under the following broad headings:
 - CJD and human TSEs, including human TSE diagnosis
 - BSE and animal by-products
 - TSEs in small ruminants
 - Cellular pathogenesis, transmission and nature of the TSE agent
 - TSE diagnostics
 - Therapeutics
 - TSE (non-CJD) surveillance
 - Sample banks and archives
 - Other
4. In most cases the purpose and aims of the projects have been summarised insofar as the information is available. The projects have been listed in order of their recorded end dates.
5. Reporting on EU research projects has been modified over the last decade or so. Defra do not have output reports from these projects. In some cases this will be available in the scientific literature.
